The Nickle Tour

When we get an opportunity to show off to visitors at Lucasey Manufacturing, we give them what I like to call the, "Nickle Tour." It takes about, 5, OK more like 15, minutes to walk around the shop and take a quick look at all that we do to manufacture products at Lucasey. In this news letter edition, you will get the nickle tour in photo form.

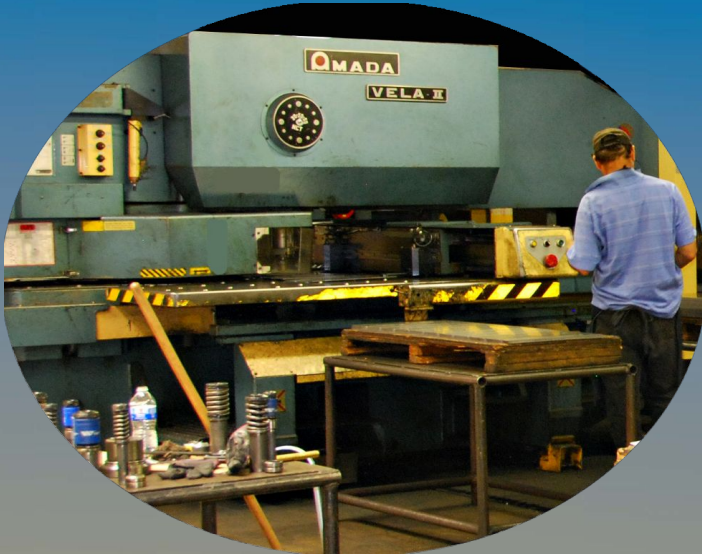
We usually start the tour at the material receiving dock where we receive truck loads of steel and other raw materials to use in manufacturing. The first picture is showing our very large shear capable of chopping up tons of sheet metal. What a great picture of our long-time dedicated shear operator. Experienced operators and good equipment make for a flexible manufacturing process that can be used to make a wide variety of products.

The next step in the process after shearing the sheet metal into usable size pieces is to get the metal punched. We have several turret punch presses that can be programmed to punch a pattern into flat sheet metal. This CNC machinery is another key to the capability at Lucasey to make 1000s of different products.

After the sheet metal is punched, we use programmable press breaks to bend the parts as needed. These first three steps in manufacturing provide foundation processes for the production of all of our products.

Welding parts is needed for a lot of tubing and sheet metal parts that we use in manufacturing. Our very experienced welders and extra welding equipment give us capacity to handle large orders.

Our environmentally friendly powder coating process can be used to paint parts individually or on a continuous feed line. We can bake the finish onto very large parts in a 10' oven or with the ovens on the continuous feed line. That's me showing off all the colors we can do.

Packaging is done by knowledgeable employees that are careful to make sure that each product contains all that is required for each order.

Our new fork lift and long-time driver are moving parts around our shipping dock. There is the quick tour of manufacturing at Lucasey. We're ready for your orders.
